

PIRATE POINTS!

>>Our 2nd Grade Behavior/Management System<<

Each day, following the classroom expectations is very important for your child. This system is used so students are able to learn in a fun, safe environment!

How our Pirate Points work:

- At the beginning of each day, all students start on “green” (ready to learn). Throughout the day, I ask them to “clip up” or “clip down” depending on their behavior.
 - Clip Up Behaviors – “blue” (good day)
 - “purple” (great day)
 - “pink” (outstanding day)
 - >>following directions
 - >>quick transitions between subjects/projects
 - >>helpful/respectful to other students/teachers
 - >>being a TEAM while walking through the hallway
 - Clip Down Behaviors – “yellow” (think about it)
 - “orange” (teacher choice)
 - “red” (parent contact)
 - >>being disrespectful
 - >>not being on task
 - >>having trouble following directions
 - >>blurting answers (not raising hand)
- Those are just a few to give you an idea how your child is expected to behave throughout the day.
- Your child has a Pirate Points folder, and we track behavior at the end of each day on a monthly calendar.
- At the end of each week, I will send home a report of your child’s behavior (which you will see attached).
